
Gondwana

The Gondwana is a Roter Veltliner that is intended to emphasize new facets of the Roter Veltliner through a longer maceration time. The grapes grew on soil that is characterized by loess and gravel.

Harvest - 12 October

Alkohol -13.00

residual sugar - 2.50 g/l

acidity -7.20 g/l

Bottles - 951

The grapes for this Roter Veltliner were hand-harvested and destemmed on September 22nd. In addition to the vineyard's location, the very long fermentation in a concrete egg also influenced the wine, which now boasts a playful combination of complex fruit aromas and a firm structure. The wine was allowed to develop with all its lees in large wooden barrels until shortly before bottling, after which it was bottled unfiltered.
